#### ***General Function (Description):***

Applications are now being accepted for a tenure track faculty position at the assistant professor level in order to teach research to graduate level students in the MSW and Ph.D. programs of the Whitney M. Young, Jr., School of Social Work (WMYJSSW). Applicants must have a Master of Social Work (MSW) degree, an earned doctorate in social work and a minimum of two years work experience beyond the doctoral level. Applicants are expected to demonstrate substantial evidence of productive research. Salary is commensurate with qualifications and work.

#### ***Duties and Responsibilities:***

Applicant must teach graduate level research courses; supervise the development and completion of theses and dissertations; identify, develop and assist in the development of proposals for funding; and assist the administration and faculty with data collection and analysis.

#### ***Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:***

Applicant must demonstrate ability to explain and conduct qualitative and quantitative research; design survey questionnaires which demonstrate psychometric properties; and use computer technology in support of program operations.

#### ***Minimum Hiring Standards:***
