COUNSELING FACULTY POSITION**

The School of Education, invites applications for a tenure-track position in the Counselor Education Department at the Assistant Professor. Ph.D. or Ed. D. required from a CACREP (Counselor Education) Program preferred.

Requirements: Applicants must hold NCC credentials, and Georgia LPC Licensed or eligible. In addition, P-12 experience as a certified school counselor is required. The Department will consider applicants that are eligible to become certified as a school counselor in Georgia within the year of hire. Teaching excellence (graduate) and an active research program is expected. Formal training or experience in clinical supervision of student counselors; a strong affiliation with the counseling professions (ASCA, ACA, ACES); experience in research/creative activity and service is expected. Clark Atlanta University seeks applicants committed to using integrative technologies in teaching.

Preferred: Experience with the preparation for accreditation, relevant experience in the counseling profession, evidence of teaching effectiveness at the graduate level, and evidence of scholarly ability. For this position, primary responsibilities include teaching core courses, supervision of practicum/internship master's students, advising master's students, faculty committee responsibilities, community service, and continuing professional development.

Application Procedures:

Candidates should submit the following documents: (1) a cover letter describing how their educational background and professional experience meet the required and preferred qualifications for the position, (2) a current curriculum vitae, an unofficial transcript, and (3) at least four professional letters of recommendation. References should have current knowledge of candidates' professional work. An official or certified copy of transcripts, proof of degree, proof of license and proof of certification will be required prior to any interview as a finalist for this position.
