### **Panthers Win in Overtime**

In the repeat matchup between the Panthers of Clark Atlanta University (CAU) and the Rams of Albany State University (ASU), it took more than the allotted time to determine the winner. In fact, it took an overtime period for the teams to settle their on-court differences. And after the final whistle, the Panthers came away the winner, 66-65.

CAU took a seven-point lead into the halftime intermission, 27-20. An 11 of 26 CAU shooting performance compared to an eight of 28 effort by ASU gave the Panthers the early lead.

In the second half, the seven-point scoring margin shifted to the Rams. They shot 40.9% (9 of 22) from the floor while CAU shot 35.5% (11 of 31). The scoring swing hinged on the fact that of the nine ASU baskets, four were three-point shots. At the end of regulation, the game was tied at 57.

In the overtime period, the Panthers scored nine points and held the Rams to eight. CAU won by a final score of 66-65.

Kevin Johnson, Najee Lane and Coshune Bingham were the leading scorers for CAU. Johnson finished with 15 points, while Lane and Bingham each contributed 13 points.

The win increases the Panthers' season mark to 10-11 and 9-7 in conference play.
