JOHNSON BREAKS SLUMP TO LEAD PANTHERS OVER RAMS

Prior to tonight's conference game against the Rams of Albany State University, Clark Atlanta point guard Kevin Johnson must have felt that he was in the middle of a collegiate nightmare. Over the last three games, the sharp shooter was a dismal 7 of 36 from the floor with a total of just 22 points.

Things changed considerably for Johnson in tonight's matchup. He would convert on five of seven attempts from the floor, four of which were three-point baskets. The junior was also perfect from the free-throw line converting on six of six attempts. On the night, Johnson finished with 20 points, one rebound, one assist, and one steal.

Johnson's effort, along with 10 points from Jahlani Heath and nine from Najee Lane, enabled the Panthers to defeat the Rams of Albany State, 64-55.
