CAU Loses Second Straight to FVSU, 72-67

With hopes of getting back on a winning streak, the Clark Atlanta University (CAU) Panthers (12-13, 11-9) were held short of victory. Despite the aggressive play from tip-off to the second-half buzzer, the Panthers were defeated by the Fort Valley State University (FVSU) Wildcats, 72-67.

Coshune Bingham shot 50 percent from the floor on his way to a double-double, scoring 11 points while hauling in 12 rebounds. Najee Lane led all scorers, hitting seven out of 15 for 17 points.

Kevin Johnson helped lead the way during the first half, scoring eight of his 10 points. The Panthers shot 32 percent from the floor, while FVSU countered making 40 percent of their shots from the floor. Even with an inferior first-half field-goal percentage, the Panthers would conclude the half leading, 33-32.

The Panthers' shooting woes continued in the second half as they connected 37 percent of their shots. The Wildcats found new life in the last half, shooting 52 percent from the field and 84 percent from the free-throw line.

The loss would leave the Panthers winless against FVSU this season.
