PANTHERS WATCH LEAD DISAPPEAR TO MAGICIANS

The momentum of their biggest win of the season against the Tigers of Benedict College a few nights ago was not enough to propel the Panthers of Clark Atlanta University (CAU) to a second consecutive conference win in their matchup with Lemoyne-Owen College on Saturday night. Despite taking a 30-28 lead into halftime, the Panthers were beaten by the Magicians, 67-62.

The game was played in Bruce Hall on the Lemoyne-Owen campus. In the first half, both teams shot less than 40% from the floor. The Panthers secured the halftime lead by converting on 11 of 30 field goals (36%) along with six free throws. The Magicians were 10 of 32 (31%) in the first half and they too converted six free throws.

As the second-half shooting of the Panthers took a dip (10 of 31 field goal attempts), the Magicians upped their shooting percentage to 50% (13-26). A plus-seven scoring margin in the second half was enough for the Magicians to make the Panther lead disappear and win the SIAC contest.

Two Panthers scored in double figures in the game. Kevin Johnson finished with a game-high 16 points while Najee Lane had 10 points for CAU.

The Panthers are now 4-6 for the season with a conference record of 3-3.
