PANTHERS RALLY TO BEAT STILLMAN

The Panthers of Clark Atlanta University (CAU) had to overcome a seven-point halftime deficit to the Tigers of Stillman College to notch their seventh win of the season. Trailing 39-32 at intermission, the Panthers outscored the Tigers 47-27 in the second half to claim their sixth Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (SIAC) win, 79-64. The win improves the Panthers' overall record to 7-7 and increases their SIAC mark to 6-4.

As a team, the Panthers shot 51% from the floor (25 of 49). Ten of the 25 Panther baskets were three pointers. The Panthers also finished 14 of 18 (77.8%) from the free-throw line.

Three Panthers finished the game with double-figure scoring. Kevin Johnson led the Panthers with 15 points and three assists. He was four of eight from the floor and three of five from the free-throw line. All four baskets were three-point conversions.

Najee Lane finished with 14 points for CAU. Lane was five of nine from the floor and a perfect three of three from the free-throw line.

Junior guard Paul Nickerson contributed 10 points to the Panther win. Nickerson was perfect from the floor and the free-throw line. He was three of three in shooting and four of four from the charity stripe.
