### **Lady Rams Too Much For Lady Panthers**

The Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (SIAC) matchup between the Lady Panthers of Clark Atlanta University (CAU) and the Lady Rams of Albany State University (ASU) featured two teams with fairly similar overall and conference records. The Lady Panthers were 12-9 overall and 8-6 in SIAC play as they entered tonight's contest. The Lady Rams were 11-10 overall and 9-6 in the SIAC as they geared up.

Played at CAU's Epps Gymnasium, this was the second and final regular season game between the teams. ASU won their first encounter in early February in Albany, Georgia.

Just as their records reflected, the first half proved to be a balanced affair. The Lady Panthers shot 34% from the floor by connecting on 11 of 32 shots. The Lady Rams were 13 of 42 (31%) from the field. At the end of the first half, neither team had a decided advantage. The halftime score was a tie at 30 points each.

In the second half the Lady Panthers converted 12 baskets out of 36 attempts (33.3%) and almost duplicated their first-half field-goal percentage. The Lady Rams increased their shooting percentage to 40.5% in the last half of the game by converting 17 of 42 shoots. The number of second-half field goals was the difference in the game. In the end, the Lady Rams were winners, 69-58.

Shantrell Moss led the Lady Panther scoring effort finishing with 19 points. She also had nine rebounds. Brittany Bell was the only other Lady Panther to reach double-digit scoring. She finished with 10 points and nine rebounds.

The Lady Panthers are now 12-10 overall and sport an 8-7 conference record.
