LADY PANTHERS RELINQUISH LEAD IN LOSS TO LADY RAMS

When you're in the midst of a five-game losing streak, the best way to climb out of the slump is to take matters into your own hands. That's precisely what the Lady Panthers of Clark Atlanta University (CAU) tried to do in tonight's conference matchup with the Lady Rams of Albany State University (ASU). And for the first half, at least, the Lady Panthers seemed destined to get the proverbial monkey off their backs.

While the Lady Panthers' first-half shooting percentage of 36% (11 of 30) was by no means their best performance, it was better than the eight for 33 start by the Lady Rams. The resulting 33-21 Lady Panther halftime lead was an encouraging sign for a team struggling to return to the win column.

As the teams returned for the second half of play in ASU's HPER Gymnasium, the obvious question was whether the Lady Panthers could hold or add to their 12-point lead. Unfortunately, the answer to that question was no!

After converting on only 8 of 26 shots in the second half, the Lady Panthers relinquished the lead to the Lady Rams who were 12 of 32 from the floor in the final 20 minutes. Despite the effort, the Lady Panthers suffered their sixth consecutive loss, 58-55.

The stellar play of Shantrell Moss continued for CAU as she led all scorers with a season-high 30 points and 13 rebounds. She was nine of 19 from the floor and 11 of 14 from the free-throw line. Danielle Walker added nine points and 11 rebounds for the Lady Panthers.
