LADY PANTHERS BEAT BENEDICT FOR 2ND STRAIGHT CONFERENCE WIN

The Lady Panthers of Clark Atlanta University (CAU) increased their Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (SIAC) record to 3-2 with a 66-48 win over the Lady Tigers of Benedict College on Monday night in the Epps Gymnasium on the CAU campus. The win takes the Lady Panthers to an overall record of 6-4.

The Lady Tigers led at halftime 28-25 despite connecting on only 7 of 28 shots from the floor. The Lady Panthers' 16 first-half fouls sent the Lady Tigers to the line 15 times and resulted in 11 additional points for the Lady Tigers.

In the second half, again it was newcomer Shantrell Moss who made the difference. Moss got 13 of her game-high 17 points to spark the Lady Panther surge. She was 5 of 8 from the floor in the last half of the game.

Danielle Walker also contributed to the Lady Panther second-half push through her 10 point performance. She finished with 14 points on the night.

Junior Jessica Wright and sophomore Whitney Reid finished the game with 11 points each.
