MOSS SHINES IN WIN OVER LADY TIGERS

It wasn't pretty but a win is a win!

That must have been the chant of the Lady Panthers of Clark Atlanta University (CAU) after their win over the Lady Tigers of Benedict College in Columbia, South Carolina. After all, it is extremely rare that you win a game when you only shoot 22% from the floor in the first half of the game. The Lady Panthers were only eight of 36 in first-half shooting. Couple that with only one basket in nine attempts from behind the three-point arch and a 51% field goal shooting effort by your opponent, and you have the formula for a certain loss. At halftime, the Lady Tigers led by 12 points, 44-32.

Now, throw in a second half in which your team shoots only 39% from the floor and your only hope of winning is that your opponent's red hot shooting subsides and somebody on your team really starts to play well. The Lady Panthers had both of their hopes realized tonight.

The Lady Tigers were eight of 33 in field goals in the second half or just 24%. This and the individual play of CAU standout Shantrell Moss turned certain defeat into a win for the Lady Panthers. Moss led a Lady Panther offense that outscored Benedict by 15 points in the second half to claim a 71-68 win.

Moss tallied 28 points, seven rebounds, three assists, two blocks, and four steals in the Lady Panther win. Danielle Walker had 14 points and seven rebounds, while Tanesha Wright finished with 11 points.

The Lady Panthers are now 12-9 overall and 7-6 in the Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (SIAC).
