RE-MATCH WITH GSW YIELDS BETTER RESULT FOR LADY PANTHERS

When the Lady Panthers of Clark Atlanta University (CAU) met Georgia Southwestern University in basketball action tonight, they were looking to avenge a season opening loss to the Lady Hurricanes. Tonight, the Lady Panthers got their revenge with an impressive 70-56 win.

In the first half both teams shot an identical 33% from the floor with each converting on 10 of 30 shots. The free throw differential (+9) in the first half favored the Lady Panthers who took a 32-25 lead into the intermission.

In the second half, the Lady Panthers were 9 of 23 from floor compared to a 10 of 26 shooting performance by the Lady Hurricanes. Again, the major scoring difference in the second half proved to be free throws. The Lady Panthers connected on 19 free throws in the second half compared to 11 for the Lady Hurricanes.

Three Lady Panthers finished with double-figure scoring led by Danielle Walker who had a game-high of 17 points. Sophomore guard Whitney Reid finished with 14 points and Tanesha Wright contributed 12 points. Sheaywond Williams had seven points and 12 rebounds for the Lady Panthers.
