LADY PANTHERS MAKE IT FOUR STRAIGHT WITH WIN OVER LADY MAGICIANS

The consecutive wins streak for the Lady Panthers of Clark Atlanta University (CAU) now stands at four after a 64-56 win over the Lady Magicians of Lemoyne-Owen College.

Off to one of the best starts since the 1999 Lady Panther team won the Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (SIAC) Championship, this year's team has many believing that a third conference crown could be a possibility in 2008. Tonight's game helped to reinforce that belief.

The "red hot" Lady Panthers took command early in the game. Converting on 14 of 29 shots in the first half, the Lady Panthers worked a bit of magic of their own by building a 32-21 halftime lead over the Lady Magicians. Defensively, the Lady Panthers held the Lemoyne-Owen to just six field goals in the first half.

In the second half, the Lady Panthers cooled off from the floor, converting just eight of 22 shots. And while the Lady Magicians hit eight field goals in the final 20 minutes, the 18 points that they collected from the free-throw line enabled them to keep the game fairly close. In fact, the Lady Magicians outscored CAU in the second half, 35-32.

But it's the two halves that make the whole! Tonight's whole story was a 64-56 win for the Lady Panthers who are now 8-4.

Tanesha Wright finished with 15 points and three assists for CAU while Shantrell Moss had 14 points and eight rebounds. Danielle Walker had a double-double for the Lady Panthers. She finished play with 12 points and 12 rebounds.
