LADY PANTHERS CONTINUE TO ROLL WITH WIN OVER LADY BEARS

The consecutive wins streak for the Lady Panthers of Clark Atlanta University (CAU) now stands at five after a 65-59 win over the Lady Bears of Miles College.

The Lady Panthers are off to the kind of start that has rejuvenated women's basketball at CAU. Winners of the 1986 and 1999 conference title, this year's version of the Lady Panthers has produced early results that make the team a serious contender for the 2008 title.

At the midway point of tonight's game, the Lady Panther win streak appeared to be in jeopardy. After CAU hit just seven first-half baskets and the Lady Bears went 12 of 37 from the floor, Miles enjoyed a seven-point lead at halftime, 35-27.

In the second half, it was the Lady Panthers who converted on 12 shots from the field, three of which were three-pointers. The news was bad for the Lady Bears in the last 20 minutes of the game. They shot only 21% from the floor as the Lady Panthers put the finishing touches on the come-from-behind win.

Shantrell Moss finished with a double-double for the Lady Panthers, 23 points and 17 rebounds. Whitney Reid had 13 points in the CAU win.
