OVERTIME WIN MAKES IT THREE IN A ROW FOR THE LADY PANTHERS

The Lady Panthers of Clark Atlanta University (CAU) increased their season record to 7-4 with an overtime 77-70 nonconference win over the Lady Falcons of Montevallo University on Wednesday night in the Epps Gymnasium on the CAU campus.

The Lady Panthers took a 32-31 lead into the intermission after shooting 37% from the floor (9 of 24). In a tightly contested first half, the Lady Panthers were led by the duo of Shantrell Moss and Danielle Walker who finished the first half with nine points each.

In the second half, the Lady Panthers shot 7 of 19 from the floor. The Lady Falcons were 10 of 30. Montevallo outscored the Lady Panthers in the second half, 30-29 including a three-point basket at the end of regulation by the Lady Falcon's Nicole Lowery forcing an overtime period.

However, clutch free-throw shooting by the Lady Panthers in the overtime period sealed the win for CAU. The Lady Panthers were 11 of 16 from the line in the overtime period.

Shantrell Moss finished as the game's high scorer with 21 points and 14 rebounds. Danielle Walker and Tanesha Wright had 16 points each.
