LADY PANTHERS WIN ATLANTA UNIVERSITY CENTER MATCHUP

When the Lady Panthers of Clark Atlanta University (CAU) took the short walk from the Henderson Athletic Center on the CAU campus to the adjacent Spelman College gymnasium, the thing foremost on the minds of the Lady Panthers was the bragging rights that traditionally flow to the winners of any Atlanta University Center sports contests. A win tonight against the Spelman College Jaguars would place those rights solidly with the Lady Panthers.

After a first half in which the Lady Panthers shot 10 of 28 from the floor and the Jaguars went 10 of 26, the question of who would win the annual match up was still very much in doubt. While the Lady Panthers led at halftime 32-26, it was clear that the Jaguars were not about to cede bragging rights without a stiff challenge.

However, in the second half the Lady Panthers increased their lead by an additional five points by outscoring the Jaguars 41-36. The Lady Panthers converted on 10 of 24 shots in the second half while Spelman hit 11 of 33. Despite being out re-bounded 44-34, the Lady Panthers won the game, 73-62.

CAU junior guard Jessica Wright was the game's high scorer with 28 points. She was five of nine from the floor and she hit four of seven three-point shots. Danielle Walker finished with 18 points and eight rebounds for the Lady Panthers. Whitney Reid also contributed 11 points to the Lady Panther win.
