LADY PANTHERS SUFFER FIRST CONFERENCE DEFEAT

The Clark Atlanta University (CAU) Lady Panthers suffered their first conference loss of the season with a 70-41 defeat at the hands of the Tigerettes of Tuskegee University in the Epps Gymnasium tonight.

Despite having the home court advantage, the Lady Panthers struggled offensively the entire game. In fact, in the first half, they managed only six baskets on 26 attempts. The Tigerettes converted on 13 of 39 shots. The Tigerettes led at halftime, 35-16.

Things got only slightly better for the Lady Panthers in the second half. While they managed to increase their field-goal percentage to 30% in the second half, the total of 15 field goals in the entire game was simply not enough to keep pace with the Tigerettes, who duplicated their first half output of 35 points in the second half.

Tanesha Wright was the only Lady Panther to reach double figures in scoring. She finished with 10 points.

The Lady Panthers are now 2-2 overall and 1-1 in conference play. Their next opponent is the Lady Panthers of Claflin University on December 1st in Orangeburg, South Carolina.
