LADY PANTHERS' STREAK STOPPED AT SIX

The Lady Panthers of Clark Atlanta University (CAU) saw their consecutive game wins streak stopped at six after a 61-47 loss to the Tigerettes of Tuskegee University in Tuskegee, Alabama.

Although three Lady Panthers finished the game in double-figure scoring, it was poor field-goal shooting that prevented CAU from claiming their seventh straight win. In the first half, the Lady Panthers converted on only 10 of 32 shots in a 31% effort. The second half proved even worse. CAU could manage only eight of 37 from the floor for a dismal 21% second-half shooting performance. For the game, the Lady Panthers were 18 of 69 or just 26%.

While the Lady Panthers had not lost a game since January 3, tonight's conference loss was the second to the Tigerettes of Tuskegee this year.

Shantrell Moss led the Lady Panthers in scoring and rebounds with 15 points and 10 rebounds. Danielle Walker finished with 12 points and seven rebounds, while Sheaywond Williams had 10 points and six rebounds.
