The Department of Counseling and Psychological Studies invites applications for two tenure-track positions in the Counselor Education Program at the Assistant Professor level. Ph.D. or Ed. D. required. Ph.D. or Ed. D. from a CACREP (Counselor Education) Program preferred. One position is in the Community Counseling Program and one in the School Counseling Program.

Applicants must hold NCC credentials, and be Georgia LPC Licensed or eligible. In addition, applicants for the school counseling position must be a Georgia-certified school counselor or eligible and a primary identification with the profession of school counseling is required, with a focus of implementing the ACSA model. Candidates for both positions are expected to have formal training or experience in clinical supervision of student counselors, a strong affiliation with the counseling professions (ACA, ACES) experience in research/creative activity and service is expected. Clark Atlanta University seeks candidates committed to using integrative technologies in teaching. **Preferred:** Experience with the preparation of a CACREP self-study, relevant experience in the counseling profession, evidence of teaching effectiveness, and evidence of scholarly ability. For all positions, primary responsibilities include teaching core School and Community Counseling courses, supervision of practicum/internship master's students, advising master's students, faculty committee responsibilities, community service, and continuing professional development.
