## CAU Trustee Ernest Green Honored By President George Bush



CAU trustee Ernest G. Green, one of the nine black students in Little Rock, Ark., who were escorted into all-white Central High School in 1957 following the historic 1954 Brown vs. Board of Education decision, was honored yesterday by President Bush during a White House event celebrating black history. The U.S. Supreme Court decision declared segregation illegal and the high school students later became known as the "Little Rock Nine." Previously, former President Bill Clinton presented the students with the highest honor this nation gives to a civilian, the "Congressional Gold Medal." Green is managing director of Public Finance for Lehman Brothers' Washington, D.C. office. He received a Bachelor of Science degree in social science and a master's degree in sociology from Michigan State University.
