CAU Celebrates Founders Day March 18

Who: CAU administrators, faculty, staff, alumni and students

What: Will celebrate Founders Day

When: Tuesday, March 18, 2008, at 1:30 p.m.

Where: The Leonida S. Epps Gymnasium (at the corner of Fair Street and Vine Street)

Background: The speaker is Dr. Pearlie Craft Dove, an alumna of Clark College ('41) and Atlanta University ('43), who retired from Clark Atlanta University in 1986 as Distinguished Professor of Higher Education. She was appointed Professor Emerita in 1993.

Formed in 1988 by the consolidation of two historic institutions, Atlanta University (1865) and Clark College (1869), Clark Atlanta University is the largest of the United Negro College Fund institutions with an enrollment of more than 4,000 students. Clark Atlanta University is accredited by the Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (1866 Southern Lane, Decatur, Georgia, 30033-4097; Telephone 404-679-4501) to award the Bachelor's, Master's, Specialist and Doctor's degrees. The Carnegie Classification lists CAU as a Research University – High Research Activity.
