Dear Returning Students:

The purpose of this letter is to update you on the availability of on-campus housing for the Fall 2008 semester. Over the past five months, Clark Atlanta University has implemented an aggressive campaign to assist our upper-class students with their housing needs. We have successfully placed over 1000 students in Brawley, Heritage, ITC-Gammon and other halls for the upcoming semester.

However, I regret to inform you that as of this date, we have reached our capacity for housing returning students. In an effort to be of all possible further assistance, I suggest there is an option still available to you. You should immediately contact one of the collegiate student housing placement agencies in the Atlanta area for assistance in obtaining an off-campus space. I understand there are over 2000 housing properties that are available. Many are conveniently located near CAU (see attachment). Clark Atlanta University does not endorse any specific agency. While a few on-campus spaces may still become available because of “no shows,” this is probably not a viable option.

Clark Atlanta continues to improve its capacity for on-campus living. This fall the newly renovated Pfeiffer Hall will be back on line. Later this year Merner and Holmes Halls will again be available. Should conditions improve, I will contact you again.
