


Installing a supported Adobe app on your Chromebook is easy. Just follow the detailed illustrative steps below.

### Prerequisite

Chromebook OS version 53 or above is required to run Android apps. To check the version of Chrome OS installed on your Chromebook, in the Chrome browser, type **chrome://help/** in the URL bar and then press Enter.

Steps to install the app:

### Sign in to Google Play Store

1. Click your account picture in the Chrome OS status area.
2. Click the  icon (Settings).




3. On the Settings page, in the Google Play Store (beta) area, select **Enable Google Play Store On Your Chromebook**.

4. Click **Get Started**.
5. Agree to the terms of service and click **Sign In**.
6. Click **Accept**.

## Install the app

1. Click the  icon in the Chrome OS shelf to open Google Play Store.
2. Search for the Adobe app you want to install; for example, Photoshop Express or Lightroom for mobile.



3. Click **Install**.



4. Launch the app by clicking **Open**. You can also click the Start icon to search for the app and launch it.
