

Shooting Inquiry Script

Thank you for calling Clark Atlanta University. Is this call related to the incident last night?

If so, here is what we know at this time:

At approximately 10:32 p.m. last night, Tuesday, August 20, 2019, Clark Atlanta University Department of Public Safety responded to a shooting in the area of the Atlanta University Center Robert W. Woodruff Library. Four students from the Atlanta University Center student were shot while attending an unsanctioned block party near campus; two of the students were from Clark Atlanta University and two were from Spelman College. The students were transported to the hospital and sustained non-life threatening injuries. The Dean of Student Affairs and the University Chaplain were onsite at the hospital to check on the condition of the students. Clark Atlanta University Public Safety is working with Atlanta Police Department, who is the lead agency on this incident, to identify all suspect(s) involved.

CAU Public Safety has shared the following advisory:

- There is no reason to believe that this incident represents an on-going threat to any individual or the community at large.
- No suspects have **been** identified at this time and the incident is being investigated by the Atlanta Police Department.

Members of the Office of Student Affairs have been in touch with the students and their families and are providing assistance, and I will be visiting the students at the hospital. The entire CAU community is here to support the students and their families during this difficult time.

We will keep you updated as more information becomes available.
