You can always verify your textbooks in Canvas. By Selecting “My Materials”. Once in My Materials, you need to make sure your Workspace is set to ‘Adopt’. Once in ‘My Materials – Adopt’ you will be able to see the digital materials you have adopted for the course.

To know if your students will have a Kortext digital textbook or physical textbook. You change the workspace from ‘Adopt’ to ‘Shelf’. This is a list of the materials you have access to. Your class’s digital books will be displayed on the screen. To access the digital materials, you will need to click the ‘Launch’ button and you will then be taken directly to the material.

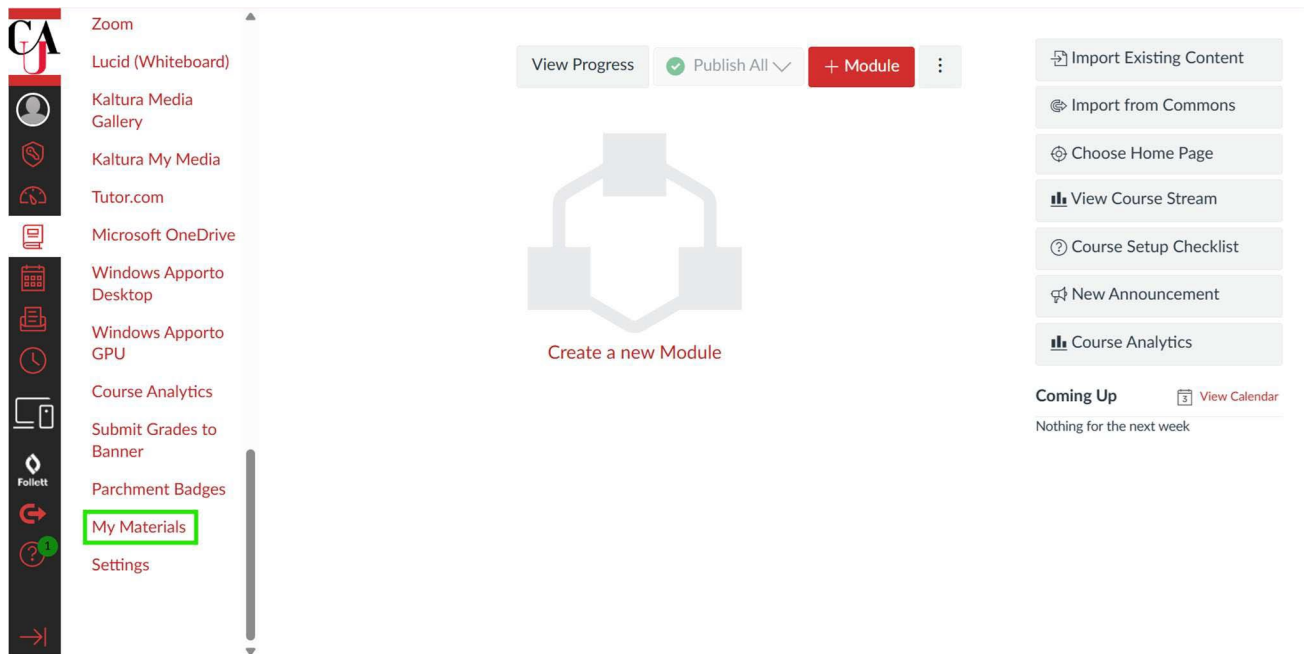

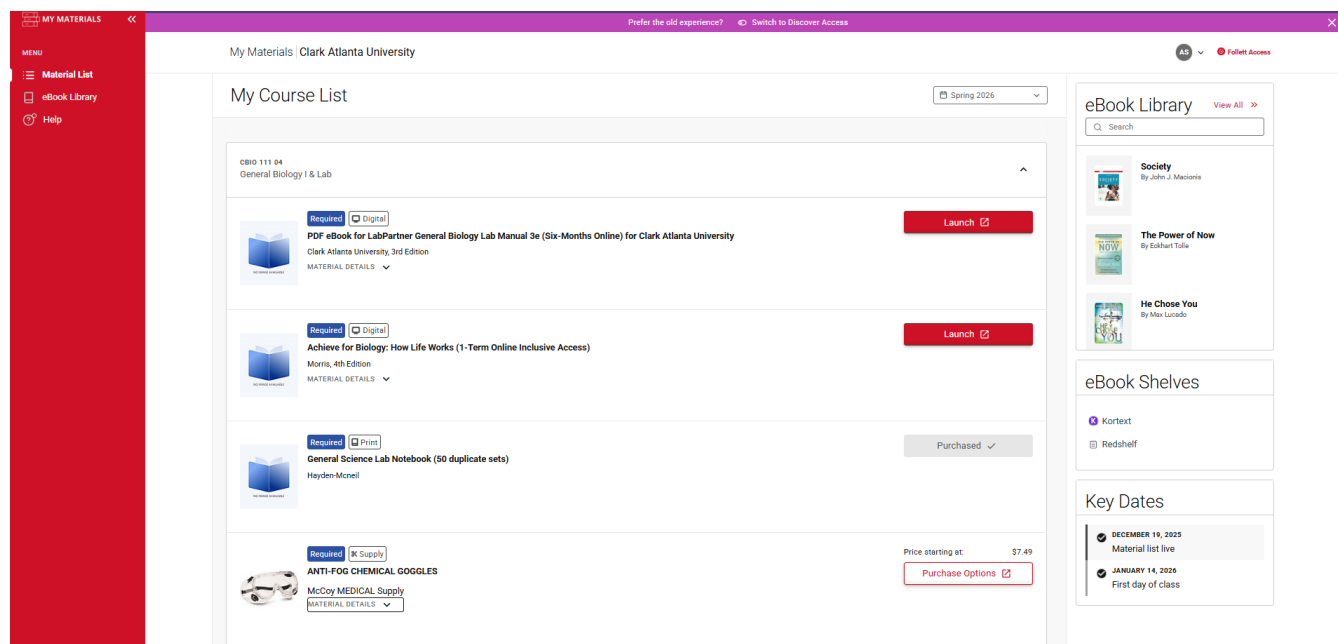

When students have materials:

The My Materials link in Canvas (screenshot of placement below) allows students participating the in the Book Bundle program to see all materials in one place.



Here is an example of what the student screen should look like:



Note on the right the Launch Button in red. In order to access their etext, students will need to click the launch button the first time they access the material. Clicking this will take them directly to their material on the host site. After this verification step has been completed, future access can be either from this location or by going directly to their Kortext Library Shelf.

Purchase texts, indicated above by the red outlined button that reads 'Purchase Options' is an indication that the student's materials are physical. Students will need to pick up physical materials at the CAU Campus Bookstore.

Students with Courseware access that material by clicking directly on the assignment links on the Canvas page for the course. The ebooks for courseware are accessed directly from within the assignment links. (See below for more detail.)

Courses that use Courseware such as the following examples: MacMillian Learning Achieve, WW Norton Inquisitive, Wiley Plus, McGraw-Hill Connect, Cengage Mindtap et.al, Vista Higher Learning, and Knewton are delivered through Canvas.

 - This is for if an instructor is using CNOWv2 (eBook is included with CNOWv2) and they only have the main CNOWv2 link in their Canvas course shell. This is how to bring in assignment/content links.
- Canvas/OWLv2: Create a Course
 - This is for if an instructor is using OWLv2 (eBook is included with OWLv2) and they do not have any Cengage/OWLv2 links in their Canvas course shell. This is only to bring the main link into the Canvas course
- Canvas/WebAssign: Create a Class
 - This is for if an instructor is using WebAssign (eBook is included with WebAssign) and they do not have any Cengage/WebAssign links in their Canvas course shell. This is only to bring the main link into the Canvas course

- Canvas/WebAssign: Link to Existing Class
 - This is for if the instructor already has a WebAssign course created and they need to link it to Canvas
