 - Your digital books are in (Kortext or Canvas), Access codes (Labster, Chem101, CMUS, CCIS, CBUS are physical code and Rental textbooks are to be picked up at the Campus Store)
 - (Please check Spam and Other).

The My Materials link in Canvas (screenshot of placement below) allows students participating in the Book Bundle program to see all materials in one place.



Physical Material will be shown as "Purchased" and will be available for pick up in the bookstore. eBooks will show as available to Launch. You can use this link to go directly to the material, or you can use the side menu on the right or left to go directly to your eBook shelves or Library.

Optional or recommended material will have a "purchase" button that redirects you to the Bookstore to show purchase options.

Courseware (software needed to do homework, such as MyLab, Achieve, etc) will have a direct link in Canvas. It will show as "See Course in LMS," or have a Launch button that redirects to the course. For these items, you will need to go to the course in Canvas to look for the direct link (often found in Modules).

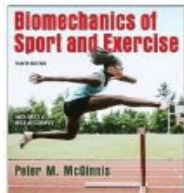
Using Kortext, you can simply search for keywords and phrases, highlight, make notes, create references and more!

How to Access Your Course Materials with Willo

All LMS Platforms – Canvas, Blackboard, Brightspace/D2L, and Moodle

Follow the steps below to locate, launch, and successfully access your digital course materials – no matter which learning platform your school uses.

1 Open Your Course

Log in to your school's LMS and open the course that uses digital materials.

2 Go to Your Course Module or Content Area

Find the **Course Materials / Publisher Links** and click the link that launches your digital materials. It may be labeled:

- eBook Access
- Course Materials or Resources
- Publisher Courseware

When clicked, it routes you to your correct eBook or publisher courseware.

Click on the link that says "Course Materials" or "Publisher Links" in the left sidebar.

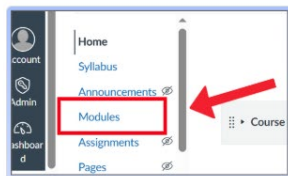

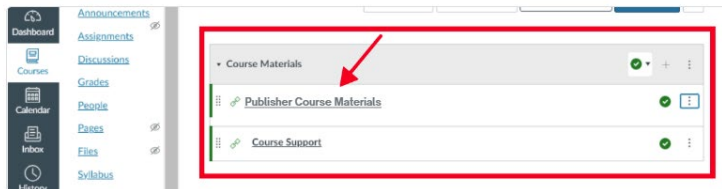
