Crime Prevention Information

- Report trespassers, suspicious activity, and policy violations (weapons, harassment, obscene behavior).
- Follow visitation rules and carry/display your Panther Paw Card.

- Stay alert—avoid earbuds in both ears, phone distractions, or propping doors open.
- Report broken locks, access devices, or security equipment.
- Don’t carry large sums of money or show electronics in public.
