



Enrollment by Term and Academic Level

Enrollment is a key performance indicator for Clark Atlanta University (CAU). CAU tracks the undergraduate and graduate student enrollment. Since last Spring, the Spring headcount (3713) increased by 3.95%. Undergraduate headcount (3090) increased by 5.97% and graduate headcount (623) decreased by 5.03%.

For graduate level students are as follows: Number of FT GR Headcount plus Total PT GR credit hours converted to FT (divide Total PT hours by 9).
