

## **Guidelines for Dissertation Oral Defense**

**Opening & Introductions** (by Committee Chair)...... **5-10 minutes** *\*Brief statement about format of Dissertation Defense* 

## Your presentation should include, but is not limited to the following questions:

- Provide the Title and Thesis of Dissertation.
- What is the purpose of the study? What arguments and theories are central to the dissertation?
- What research methods were applied and why?
- What were the significant conclusions of the research?
- What were some of the limitations encountered during the research process?
- Discuss the primary and secondary sources used to carry out this project.
- What are the implications of this research? Can the study be expanded in the future?

Deliberation of Committee Members (Candidate & Guests will leave the room)	10 minutes
Candidate returns for comments (by Committee)	10-15 minutes
Decision Announcement and Closing Remarks (Committee Chair)	5-10 minutes
