


The Six Step "Loop"

Step 02: Identify Assessment Methods


Step 03: Establish Criteria of Success



SCREEN ONE:

- 1. Select the **Program (GE) General Education** name from the drop-down menu at the top of the screen if assigned more than one program. If only one program is assigned it will be the only option to choose.

- 3. Click the **Assessment Results** tab below the Gen Ed Assessment tab.







Entering Assessment Results – General Education

SCREEN TWO:

- 1. Click the **drop-down triangle** of the learning outcome to which you wish to add results. This reveals the Courses assigned to the outcome.
- 2. Click the green **Add Result** button at the right end of the Course for which you are adding results. This reveals the next set of data fields.
- 3. Click within the text field of the **Result** and type a summary of the assessment results.
- 4. Click the drop-down triangle of the **Assessment Year** and select this academic year.
- 5. Click the drop-down triangle of the **Criterion Met** and select Yes. No.
- 6. Click within the text field of the **Assessment Tool** and enter what assessment tool(s) were used.
- 7. In the **Criterion** text field, type the specific performance level or degree that defines successful achievement.
- 8. Click within the text field of **Assessment Schedule** and enter "Annual."
- 9. Click within the text field of **Section(s) Assessed** and enter the sections of the course that were assessed.
- 10. In the **Planned Action** text field, type the action(s) that will be taken to achieve improvement in this outcome.
- 11. Click the drop-down triangle of the **Save** button and select Save and Return.
