#### ***General Function (Description):***

The Department of Management in the School of Business at Clark Atlanta University (CAU) is seeking applications for a tenure-track Assistant or Associate faculty position in the area of Sports & Entertainment Management. This position will be expected to help significantly grow and shape the school's research profile and provide forward leaning teaching in Sports & Entertainment Management.

The teaching responsibilities associated with this position includes upper and lower level undergraduate courses and graduate courses in the Sports and Entertainment Concentration. Candidates are expected to have a commitment to excellence in teaching, mentoring student experiential learning opportunities, scholarly activity and service. Rank will be based on experience and record of achievement.

#### ***Examples of Duties and Responsibilities:***

##### ***Teaching***

- Develop and deliver undergraduate and/or graduate courses in sports and entertainment management, ensuring alignment with the curriculum and learning objectives.
- Utilize diverse and effective teaching methods to engage students and facilitate a positive learning environment.
- Provide timely and constructive feedback on student assignments, projects, and exams.
- Foster critical thinking and analytical skills among students in the field of sports management.
- Advise and mentor students in the School of Business and support experiential learning opportunities

##### ***Research***

- Conduct and publish research in reputable academic journals, conferences, and other scholarly outlets within the sports and entertainment management field.
- Pursue grant opportunities and research funding to support scholarly activities.
- Stay current with industry trends, contribute to the academic discourse, and integrate research findings into teaching and service to the community.

##### ***Service***

- Provide service within your expertise to the Department of Management, School of Business, Clark Atlanta University, the profession, and the community
- Participate actively in departmental meetings, committees, and other service-related activities.
- Contribute to the development and assessment of the sports management curriculum.
- Collaborate with colleagues to enhance the overall academic and professional environment within the department and university.
