## **General Function (Description):**

- Communicate project status to senior management and stakeholders
- Allocate resources, with PI approval, and manage project budgets
- Manage the office's daily operations
- Provide administrative support to the PI and senior management team
- Schedule and coordinate meetings, appointments, and travel arrangements
- Prepare and edit correspondence, reports, and presentations
- Oversee the logistics of maintaining office supplies and equipment
- Handle confidential information with discretion
- Coordinate logistics for program events and meetings, as well as travel logistics
- Manage office budgets
- Ensure compliance with program policies and procedures
